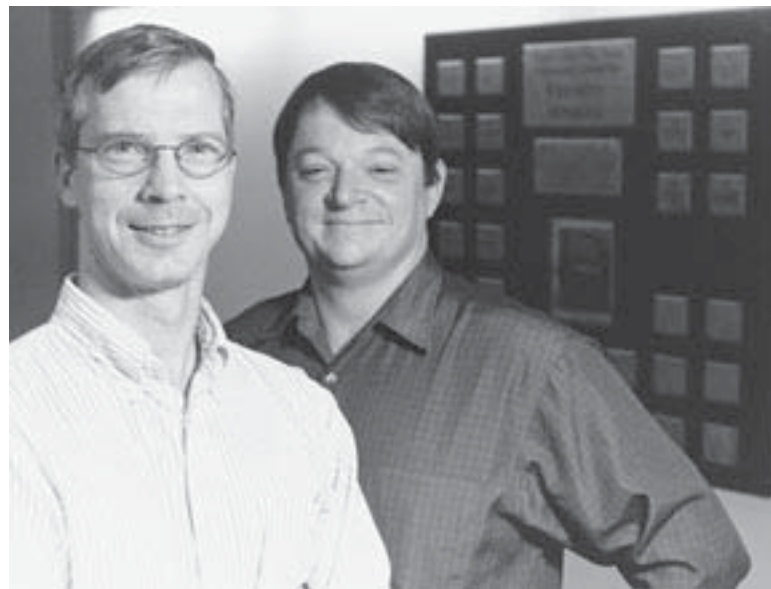

David Danehower and Ross Whetten Receive 2001 NCSU Libraries Faculty Award

This year, two NC State faculty members will receive the prestigious NCSU Libraries Faculty Award for their outstanding contributions in support of the Libraries' mission and its role within the university. **David Danehower, associate professor of crop science in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, and Ross Whetten, associate professor of forestry in the College of Natural Resources, have collaborated with the Libraries on many important projects, most notably in furtherance of the library's scholarly communication program.**

Danehower and Whetten, working with library staff and members of the University Library Committee's Scholarly Communication Subcommittee, co-chaired the NC State Copyright Ownership Task Force (COTF), the first of its kind in

the UNC system. Their dedicated support of the Libraries' scholarly communication colloquia and seminars has helped to raise campus awareness of the NCSU Libraries' role in the area of scholarly communication. As co-chairs of COTF, Danehower and Whetten led three Copyright Ownership Town Meetings to discuss possible revisions to NCSU's copyright ownership policy and to garner faculty input on what the task force policy recommendations should include. Their invaluable past and current contributions to the library over the last decade make them outstand-

ing and deserving recipients of the NCSU Libraries Faculty Award. Previous winners of the Faculty Award include Lewis L. Deitz of the NCSU Department of Entomology (1999) and Hugh A. Devine of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism (2000).
